At the moment, Finham Parish Council is seeking information, reasoning and clarity from Coventry City Council, particularly about the Highways Plan for this area which will have to cope with 8,000 extra cars and which encourages emergency vehicles to use the urban roads of Finham to gain access onto the Kings Hill development.

Decisions have been made over the past few years apparently without the input of residents in the area and not just those of Finham. Residents on Stoneleigh Road will also be adversely affected, and their views have not been taken into account in any tangible way.

Consultation must be a two-way flow and not just developers and councils listening and reading our concerns and then seemingly ignoring them all without adequate explanations.

There is little to say at the moment. Questions have been put to representatives of CCC but to date there have been no answers.

Be assured that when we do receive information, reasoning and clarity on the issues that worry many many residents, we will let you know.
